A Note from Rick: Markets were a little softer across the board this week at TLA. We had a big run of calves and butcher cows this week. We also had a bigger than normal offering of Springers and Fresh Cows for a Tuesday sale. Springers and Fresh Cows ranged from \$1500 to \$1900 and we had a nice selection of Holstein Breeder Bulls that sold for \$1100 to \$1300 (weighing around 1,000 lbs). The calf market was off slightly with 85lb to 100lb Holstein Bulls ranging from \$1.30/lb to \$1.55/lb and angus cross calves ranged from \$2.10/lb to \$2.45/lb for both heifers and bulls. The Butcher Cow market was \$.03-.05/lb. lower than last week, but last week we had a jump in prices that evidently had a lot to do with the Thanksgiving holiday. The hay market was steady with good coarse hay ranging from \$160/ton to \$200/ton. Good 2nd or 3rd cutting hay ranged from \$225/ton to \$260/ton. We're gearing up for The Dutch Cross Classic this Friday and Saturday and are very excited about the lineup we have to offer. Hope to see you soon at TLA!
