**A Note from Rick:** Markets were a little softer across the board this week at TLA. Tuesday was our special feeder sale for the month of June. We had a variety of cattle to offer that sold well. Prices weren't quite as strong as the previous two months. Fat cattle and butcher cows were kind of the same story. They are still selling very well with very good prices, but not quite as high as they were previously. Bull calves may be the one exception. They seem to be hanging in there, price wise and really haven't softened. It's hard to believe that the Fourth of July is right around the corner. We've seen a lot of very high prices in the first half of 2023. Nearly all sectors of the Ag Industry at some point during these past six months have had them. Currently there are a few markets, especially milk and pork, that have seen major declines in prices. All in all, there is a good bit of uncertainty as we enter the second half of 2023 about where these markets will go. It seems to me that there are some that are way too high and others that are way too low. Have a safe and Happy Fourth of July weekend and we hope to see you soon at TLA.

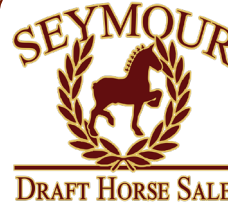
