CHECK IN: Horses may arrive anytime Tuesday, July 11th or Wednesday, July 12th. Please visit the office upon arrival so that we can give you show information, numbers cards, food tickets and wrist bands. We can also show you where you will be stalled.

COGGINS/HEALTH PAPERS: All horses must have an up to date, original negative Coggins test. Horses coming from outside of Indiana will have to have an interstate health certificate that meets the State of Indiana requirements to travel.

SHOW VETERINARIAN: King Animal Clinic is located across the street at 620 E Lake Street in Topeka, IN. Phone number is (260) 593-2482. Please contact Rick or Andrea if a vet is needed after hours.

HORSE SHOW RULES:

1. Hitch entries due June 1, 2023. Entries must include entry fees and be postmarked by June 1. Checks can be made payable to Topeka Livestock Auction. Credit Card payments can be made by calling the office.

2. Entry fees are non-refundable.

3. The gates will be closed for each class at the discretion of the ringmaster. The judge or ringmaster may also excuse any entry deemed to be unsafe.

4. Proper dress apparel (including no denim jeans) will be required of exhibitors and headers while in the show ring.

5. Youth cart class may be divided by age depending on the number of entries and ages.

ENTRY FEE: \$1500- Includes 10 box stalls, 8 wrist bands and all shavings. Entry fee for exhibitors with less than 6 horses will be \$50 per horse plus the amount of stalls that you request. 2 wristbands per horse will be included along with shavings.

BEDDING: Shavings are included in your entry fee.

WRISTBANDS: 8 wristbands will be provided for entries with at least 6 horses. Exhibitors with less than 6 horses will be provided 2 wristbands per horse. Additional exhibitor wristbands (good for all three days of the event) may be purchased at a reduced rate, in advance, on your entry form for \$20 each. If purchased at the event, wristbands will be \$10 per day.

CLASSIC SERIES MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: North American Six Horse Hitch Classic Series: All entries in the qualifying class must be current members of the Six Horse Hitch Classic Series with a membership number to compete in the class.

Every exhibitor is urged to keep attendants at their exhibits at all times and carry insurance for their protection against any losses which might be incurred and to protect themselves from risks assumed under this clause. The TLA Classic Show and Topeka Livestock Auction is NOT liable for any accidents.

- 3. Manure must be placed in designated areas.
- 4. Wash bays are available in back of stalling barn
- 5. Concession Stand will be available during shows and limited times in during the day.
- 6. Vending machines with pop and water are always available.
- 7. TLA Apparel and hats are available in the office.
- 8. There are no available showers/camping hook ups.
- 9. There will be designated areas for self contained RVs.
- 10. Restrooms are available inside the horse arena and on the outside by the office.


