**A Note from Rick:** No real highlights to report in the markets this week at TLA; more of the same trends with very little change in any specific category. The hay market is starting to be more active as we enter into that time of year. There seems to be a big price difference between the top-quality hay, which is bringing \$220-\$250/ton, & the average to lesser quality hay which is \$100-\$150/ton. On the livestock side, I'd say the springers & fresh cows, as well as the calf market, continue to be very strong. These markets have been on this trend for quite some time now & it shows no signs of slowing down. Butcher cows & fat cattle continue to trend a little softer compared to the highs we saw last Summer & early Fall. Typically, this market rebounds a bit after the Fall run of higher numbers hitting the market. We're nearing that time & it wouldn't surprise me to see a little more demand that could strengthen the market a little. Have a great week! We will see you soon at TLA!!
