



Project Description

The Minnie Street Corridor Study is focused on the area surrounding Minnie Street, from Illinois Street to the intersection with the Old Steese Highway.

A primary objective of the study will be to define a “vision” for the Minnie Street corridor. This “vision” will incorporate the community’s ideas and comments for future uses of Minnie Street and improvements, and be supported by a range of goals and objectives that summarize what the improvement projects will achieve.



This corridor study will begin with a mobility study, considering all transportation modes to evaluate the traffic flows, volumes, collision rates and origin-destination data. Public and agency outreach combined with technical planning and environmental analysis will define the corridor vision and develop a realistic implementation plan.

The corridor study will look at ways that residents, businesses, non-motorized, and motorized traffic can all use the Minnie Street corridor and how all parties can work together to improve the area. The study will evaluate historic improvement concepts and adjacent corridor improvements, and investigate challenges such as lack of a drainage system and how the narrow right-of-way with crowded utilities can accommodate motorized traffic, pedestrians, and bicycles.

Funding

The study is federally-funded. It will meet the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Planning and Environmental Linkage (PEL) guidelines in anticipation of further federal funding for plan implementation.
