The laser etched custom bricks will soon be installed as the concrete work has been finished. We are looking at possibly placing bricks along the south side of hole one with the idea of adding plants to that area.

With our youth excelling, improvements to our driving range are being explored to better aid in their team practice sessions.

Additional cart path improvements are in our sights as we look to continually improve and make them safer. We have also had conversations on costs to fix and potentially replace existing irrigation systems. The cart shed waiting list continues to grow with our membership. We have been getting bids on labor, concrete, and construction of an addition to the current golf cart shed and hope to be expanding that soon. As a nod to our past, we are working to integrate the Old Red Barn's Cupola somewhere on the course.
