

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The Freight Broker Certification Program is an 6-week training designed to prepare individuals for successful careers in the freight brokerage and logistics industries. Developed by the African American Women Trucking Association (AAWTA), this program equips participants with the critical skills needed to connect carriers with shippers, negotiate freight rates, and manage logistics operations with confidence and professionalism.

Participants learn the **full freight brokerage process** — from FMCSA compliance and carrier onboarding to load board navigation, rate negotiation, and client relationship building. Through real-world simulations, business readiness coaching, and one-on-one mentorship opportunities, students **gain the tools they need to either launch their own brokerage businesses or begin working as licensed freight brokers or broker agents.** 

Graduates will earn the Certified Freight Broker Professional (CFBP) credential with "AAWTA" and receive continued support through AAWTA's alumni network, career placement guidance, and business development resources.

This program offers a direct, structured pathway to entrepreneurship, financial independence, and leadership within the growing logistics and supply chain industries.

The **Freight Broker Certification Program** is a fast-paced, **6-week training** designed to prepare individuals for success in the logistics and transportation industries. Participants learn how to secure carrier and shipper relationships, negotiate rates, manage compliance, and operate freight brokerage businesses or work as licensed agents. Through real-world practice and mentorship, students earn Freight Broker Professional credential and gain the skills needed to launch their careers or businesses with confidence.

# 6-Week Agenda At-A-Glance

Weeks 1–6: Broker Industry Knowledge & Career Skill Building: The Freight Broker Certification Program provides a delivers a fast-paced foundation in brokerage operations, transportation logistics, and supply chain

**management.** Over **six weeks,** participants build the essential skills needed to become licensed freight brokers or agents, ready to launch independent businesses or secure roles with established firms.

Through technical training and real-world practice — <u>including load board navigation</u>, <u>carrier and shipper acquisition</u>, <u>rate negotiation</u>, <u>and business setup</u> — students engage in a career-focused journey supported by professional mentorship. The curriculum is designed around key workforce priorities to ensure graduates are prepared for immediate success and long-term growth in the logistics industry.

Weeks 7–8: Mentorship, Career Coaching, and Professional Readiness: After completing core training, participants enter the Road Rise Mentorship Program for two weeks of one-on-one coaching and professional development. This phase focuses on career launch strategies, business startup support, and real-world brokerage troubleshooting. Guided by experienced industry mentors, participants refine their skills, strengthen their career or business plans, and build the confidence needed to succeed as certified freight brokers or agency leaders.

- Marketing your broker business: Branding, digital presence, partnerships
- Scaling operations: Hiring agents and building teams
- Final Broker Simulation: Prospect → Negotiate → Book a Load → Complete Documentation
