WHAT IS A DISTRICT IN AA?

An Alcoholics Anonymous District is a cluster of (2-20) Groups within an Area, which have chosen to share together, supporting one another, and working closely and cooperativelyto carry the AA message more effectively: to do 12th Step Service Work.

WHAT DO DISTRICTS DO?

- Provide a two-way communication link through the DCM, between Groups and the Area Delegate and the Area Committee.
- Provide a forum where Groups can come together to share their experiences, solve problems, organise Public Information activities and work together in unity to carry the AA message.
- Set up and support AA meetings in Treatment and Correctional facilities.
- Cooperate with and support their Area and Region in fund raising, Forums, meetings and other activities.

WHAT IS A GSR?

The General Service Representative (GSR) is the link between the Group and AA as a whole, and is probably the most important single factor in the whole AA structure. The GSR represents the voice of the Group Conscience, reporting the Group's wishes to the Area through the District Committee Member(DCM) and to the Area Delegate through Area Committees and Assemblies, from where it is passed on to the Australia General Service Conference. Whatever authority there is in AA is vested in the Group Conscience and is then conveyed by the GSR and/or the DCM to the wider AA community.

AN EFFECTIVE GSR NEEDS:

- 1. To be open minded and a good listener.
- 2. To be an information gatherer.
- 3. To have a keen interest in AA as a whole.
- 4. To have a willingness to serve AA.
