**CAMP MORIAH**  
**RULES & REGULATIONS**  
**(Please return with Camp Form)**

1. Camp is divided into 2 weeks...Week 1 is Jr. Camp which is grades 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup>. Week 2 is Sr. Camp which is grades 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>, **if a camper has just graduated high school they may come to camp as a camper for that year.**
2. All Camp Workers must be born again Christians.
3. No camper will be permitted to leave the campground without permission from the camp director. If a camper drives to camp, they must turn in their keys to the office. Campers may not go into the woods or up by the farmhouse. Counselors need to check with Camp Director if they need to leave the campground for any reason.
4. Conduct and speech exhibited at camp must be in keeping with Christian principles. Respect for church services, each other and yourself is a **MUST!**
5. The use of alcohol, or tobacco products of any kind are absolutely forbidden on campground by Workers or Campers.
6. Absolutely No Pranks that hurts feelings, people or property of others or the campground
7. **Clothing worn at camp shall be in accordance with modest Christian attire. The camp director and staff can and will decide if the clothing is appropriate. Campers will be asked to change his or her clothes if they are deemed inappropriate.** Inappropriate items include spaghetti straps, mid-riff/belly shirts, backless, racerback and strapless tops and cheerleading shorts. A rule of thumb is that all shorts, skirts & dresses should be no shorter than 3-4 inches above the knee. For male campers, no tank tops & no sagging pants where boxers/briefs can be seen. **LEGGINGS ARE NOT PANTS!!!** Leggings may only be worn under a dress, skirt or very long shirt.
8. Clothing that is offensive, has double meaning or advertises alcoholic beverages, drinking establishments, tobacco or rock music is forbidden.
9. Swimming is only allowed in the pool during scheduled times. Absolutely no swimming or wading will be allowed in the pond.
10. Male campers must keep their shirts on at all times except when inside the fence at the pool.
11. Female campers, one-piece bathing suits or Tankini's only for pool.
12. Shoes, shirt & shorts must be worn to & from pool area and also on float trip.
13. **NO PDA (Public Display of Affection)**
14. **All daytime visitors MUST check-in at office.**
15. **Visitors are encouraged to attend the evening service, which begins at 7:00pm, but are asked in consideration for campers evening activities & lights out, not to stay any longer than 30 minutes after service.**
16. CD players, ipods, MP3 players, cell phones, etc. (ELECTRONICS) are not allowed. (Appropriate music may be allowed for skits, talent show, or special music, but must be approved and music players will be provided by sound technician).
17. Only in EMERGENCY will phone calls be allowed. Any other phone calls must be approved by Camp Director. Under **NO CIRCUMSTANCE** should Counselors allow a camper to use their phone.
18. **All camp rules will be enforced. The National Camp Director along with the National Youth President retains the right to send any camper home who refuses to adhere to camp rules.**
