We were just involved with several churches to do a first-of-its-kind "Christian concert" in our area. What a blessing this concert was and such a beautiful presence of the Lord. We had over 800+ people in attendance. It did not come easy in the spiritual realm. God gave us a word to speak to a group of leaders, what the enemy meant to do was crushed and the love of God shown through.

Recently, our church cooperated with forty other churches to sponsor an outreach service in a local mall (left). There were more than three thousand people in attendance. We took our members in 9 vans and then we had some non-believers in other vans. We were so excited to see more than twenty of them come to the Lord.

Since then, we have seen thirty new members come into the church and I have had the privilege of teaching a new Believer's class every Sunday (right). God is doing something in our area of Thailand. We are seeing people come to the Lord like never before. It has been a blessing seeing them so hungry for God in their lives. For so long they have trusted in religion to help them and found out that there is no way it can help change their circumstances. Now when they come to the Lord, they are ready to give their whole hearts to the Lord and that is so refreshing. It is fun to see their eyes light up when they understand for the first time who Jesus is and what HE came to do for us.





The last few weeks have been amazing to watch as God healed a spine (confirmed by the doctors). Another lady who has had difficulty walking because one of her legs was so much shorter than the other. Her hips were in such pain because she had to twist her body to walk. God extended her one leg out until her knees now are even. This miracle has taken the pressure off her hips and she is so excited. The lower part of her leg still needs to grow out, and we are believing God for that. Yet, this woman has been transformed by God's power.

Our praise and worship leader has a construction company. One of his workers was working on the second floor of a house, slipped and fell from the second floor, landing on a tree. Our praise and worship leader ran over and began to pray for this man. He got up without any broken bones, wasn't hurt and got up and began to work again. That next Sunday he and his wife came and received the Lord. They said, "If the God you serve can do miracles like this, we need to know Him"

Another lady had gone to the doctor in another city an hour from us. While going up the steep incline in the parking garage, the gear shift stopped working. Normally, their vehicle would just go backward. They were praying God help us because there were cars behind them. The vehicle had stopped on the top of the incline. They started to pray again and in their own words, "We don't know what or how it happened, but our truck went up the incline. As we came into the parking area, there was a car that pulled out and we were able to coast into the parking spot." They were shaking, but so thankful and knew that they had just experienced a miracle. After their doctor's appointment, they prayed again because they had to go down without gears. Again, God helped them get down the six floors and through an intersection to pull over to the side of the road. They were able to get a mechanic and the Lord helped them to get their truck fixed so they could come home.

Wow, God is so amazing. HE is doing so many special things amongst the new believers. They are experiencing Jesus. We have a new couple, and many times these people do not always understand about finances or loans, principles, and interest rates. That is what makes this miracle so precious. This new couple needed a motorcycle. They went around town and were looking for something secondhand. All they could find were motorcycles at 30,000 baht. It was so much money, they only had about 1,000 baht. They were going to put money down on it but they both felt they should pray. They went home and prayed, they felt to wait for three days. During that time their son contacted them. They had not spoken to their son for a long time. The son asked how they were doing, etc. And they told him they were going to have to purchase a motorcycle. The son said, no, I have several. I will give you one. The parents testified how deeply touched they were to see the miracle they had prayed for; God brought the answer through their son.

We are seeing God do some amazing things. HE is changing the spiritual atmosphere in Thailand in preparation for the coming revival here. We are so excited about the great things HE is doing in the hearts of the people. Thank you so much for your prayers and support, we could not do what we do without you.
