Human Relations Skills

-Are there certain groups of individuals that you feel you are unable to work with?

Dependability

-How do you handle a situation when you know that you are unable to complete an assignment or commitment?

-Do you have available transportation if needed?

Communication

-How comfortable do you feel speaking in front of people?
