ABOUT COSMETIC PRP

Activated platelet-rich plasma (PRP) is a revolutionary technique which has been shown to naturally stimulate collagen and elastin production in the skin without damaging it. For skin, PRP is used in facial procedures to stimulate sunken tissue, boost types I & III collagen, restore volume, soften creases, fill acne scars & promote sequential revitalization of the aging complexion. For hair loss, PRP is ideal for those who are in the early stages of androgenic (hormone-induced) alopecia. With or without hair restoration surgery, the use of PRP has been shown to boost hair follicle density and hair growth. For optimal results, PRP injection therapy should be administered in a series of 4- 6 treatments within 8 months. Effects are enhanced by peptide prescriptions, including thymosin beta, PTD and/or zinc thymulin.

Not all PRP is created equal! Dr. Parker uses an FDA-approved PRP system which is able to consistently create medical-grade PRP. This is one of the only platelet concentration systems which increases platelet concentration up to nine-times above baseline harvesting, with an average platelet count of 1,213,000/uL, and over 7.5 billion platelets in a single dose, achieving supraphysiologic PRP.
