All volunteers must provide proof of current medical coverage, have a current tetanus vaccination, sign our Release of Liability Waiver and complete our Emergency Contact Form.

Volunteers must complete the necessary training related to their volunteer position prior to beginning a regular shift and commit to a regularly scheduled shift of 2-4 hours each week, May through mid-September. Volunteers must be over 18 years of age to work hands-on with the birds.

By applying as a volunteer of Native Songbird Care & Conservation, Inc. (NSCC), you agree to uphold your responsibilities as a volunteer, follow NSCC policies and procedures, as well as fulfill your commitment to a weekly shift from May through mid-September.
