Minutes of the meeting of the Zoning Board of Appeals of the Village of New Berlin Il..

Chairman Don Prince called the meeting to order at 7:30 p. m..

Roll Call was taken. Members present were Tim Berry, Ed Cantrall, Artie Hatfield, and Gene Rhodes. Members absent were Roger Keyser, Greg Patterson, and Marsha Sweet.

A motion was made by Tim Berry to waive the reading of the minutes of the last meeting and was seconded by Gene Rhodes. The motion was approved by voice vote.

The petition for a side yard variance for the property owned by Ryan Sours of 204 N. Benton St., New Berlin, Il. was read to the members by Chairman Don Prince.

The petition requests a variance for the construction of a 12 feet six inches wide by twenty-one feet deep garage within one foot of the north property line of Sours' property. The garage would be attached to the house and would be used only for the storage of a personal vehicle and lawn equipment.

Member Tim Berry expressed concern about the overhang of the building extending into the neighbor's property, and the placement of guttering on the overhang and downspouts that would divert water onto the neighboring property.

Gene Rhodes asked if any complaints had been expressed by anyone.

Chairman Prince answered that as of the time of this meeting, there had been none.

Petitioner Ryan Sours addressed the Board and made assurances that he was willing to do whatever the Board felt necessary to protect the rights of his neighbor.

Tim Berry made a motion that the Zoning Board of Appeals recommend to the Village Board that Sours be granted a variance to construct a garage with the foundation no closer than one foot to the north property line of his property. The variance should also stipulate that any overhang on the north side of the garage not exceed six inches from the wall, that any gutter attached to the overhang not be more than five inches, and that any downspouts must divert water to the east or west so as not to run water onto the neighbor's yard.

Ed Cantrall seconded the motion.

A roll call vote was taken. Tim Berry, Ed Cantrall, Artie Hatfield, and Gene Rhodes all voted yes on the motion.

Chairman Prince informed Ryan Sours that the Zoning Board would recommend to the Village Board that his request for a variance be approved, but the Village Board would make the final decision.

Artie Hatfield made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Ed Cantrall.

All members voted to adjourn the meeting. Chairman Don Prince adjourned the meeting at 8:00 p. m..
