## VILLAGE OF NEW BERLIN ZONING BOARD MEETING Monday, September 29, 2003

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Tim Berry at 7:06 p.m. Before calling roll, Chairman Berry requested that Vince King be sworn in to serve on the Zoning Board. Vince King was appointed by President Pfeffer to fill the vacancy created by Tim Berry when Tim was appointed to become Chairman of the Zoning Board due to the resignation of Don Prince.

Roll call was taken with the following members being present: Chairman, Tim Berry; Members, Gene Rhodes, Vince King, Ed Cantrall, Artie Hatfield, and Marsha Sweet. Member Roger Keyser arrived at the meeting at 7:15 p.m.

<u>OLD BUSINESS</u> - There was no old business presented for discussion. A motion was made by Member Rhodes and seconded by Member Hatfield to waive the reading of the minutes from the August meeting, 2003. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS – The New Berlin Village Board has requested that the Zoning Board review YARD REQUIRED, Article 40-2-7, Par. C, to consider amending the requirement for rear yard depth from 25 feet to 10 feet. As explained by Mayor Pfeffer, the Board felt this would reduce requests for variances. This amendment only pertains to the rear depth and does not affect the front yard or side yard depths. After discussion, Member Hatfield made the motion to recommend to the Village Board the amendment of this Ordinance from 25 feet to 10 feet. Member King seconded the motion and motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote.

Tony Albanese who lives at 307 E. Birch has requested the consideration of two variances so that he can construct a 10' x 24' shed on the north side of his property. The placement of the shed running east and west would require a variance for 3 feet on the side and 4 feet from the rear property line. If the placement of the shed is running north and south only a variance would be needed for 5 feet from the rear property line. The west property line would meet the required 10 feet. Mr. Albanese agreed that he would place the shed on the property running north and south; thereby, needing only one variance for the 5 feet from the north property line.

The neighbor to the west was present to state that he had no objections to the placement of the shed three feet from his east property line. The neighbor to the north was not present. Mr. Albanese stated he had spoken with Mrs. Reiss and she had no objection to the placement of the shed closer to the property line. Mrs. Reiss was also contacted by the Village to make her aware of the meeting to be held tonight.

A motion was made by Member Sweet and seconded by Member Keyser to make the recommendation to the Village Board to approve the variance for a rear yard depth of five feet from the north property line. Roll call was taken and passed unanimously.

Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:44 p.m. with a motion being made by Member Rhodes and seconded by Member Hatfield.
