NEW BERLIN ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS June 25, 2013

The New Berlin Zoning Board of Appeals met on June 25, 2013 at 7:00 p.m.

Chairman Marsha Sweet opened the meeting with roll call. Members Carrie Adams, Sharon LaFauce, Vince King, Ed Cantrell, Artie Hatfield, and Marsha Sweet answering present. Audience: Doug and Susan Danenberger, John Myers, Village Attorney, Steve Frank, Dave Kuehl, Bob Fromme, and Bill Pfeffer.

The April 16, 2013 Zoning Minutes were waived from the reading with a motion by Sharon LaFauce and seconded by Vince King. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS -

Chairman Sweet explained the purpose of the meeting was to look at two proposals being presented. The Zoning Board will look over and review the information then send their recommendations to the Village Board to take in consideration when making their decision.

The two proposals to be discussed:

- 1. An Annexation Agreement Danenbergers have some property that they would like the Board to consider an annexation to the Village to be zoned agricultural.
- 2. An Ordinance Amending the Village Code of Ordinances to add a provision relating to the Agricultural and Multifamily Zones. The Village does not have R-3 at the present time.

Chairman Sweet introduced John Myers. Myers explained Danenbergers have asked for agricultural zoning. They have been growing grapes to operate a winery and want to sell their product. They are located 1/¼ miles from the Village and the Village has zoning jurisdiction for 1½ miles outside the Village. Instead of trying to get the zoning through Sangamon County, they would like to get an annexation agreement with the Village which the Village Attorney, John Myers, stated would not present a problem. The annexation agreement would put them in the agricultural zone. The Village would have to create another liquor classification.

The Village Ordinance has no definition of the agricultural zone. The proposed zoning ordinance defines agriculture.

The Village zoning ordinance is unclear on multi-zoning on where and how you can do it. The proposed ordinance defines the multi-family zone. It does not zone anyone multifamily. Anyone that wants to be zoned multifamily will have to a file an application and ask for a zoning change.
