

OAKVILLE POWER BOAT CLUB, COVID-19 GUIDELINES

1. Halton is entering into Stage 3 of re-opening today which means we can open the clubhouse. **The Clubhouse is opening Saturday July 25th 2020.** We have ordered signs and will have them in place in the next week or so. Heather Black and Samantha Richmond will be bringing our club to the necessary levels to open. In the meantime, please follow the temporary signage and follow the instructions of our staff.

According to the Government Guidelines, we can only allow 30 people in the clubhouse at a time (excluding staff). **This MUST be followed.**

In order to ensure the health and safety of our staff, members and guests, everyone will be required to follow the Covid- 19 guidelines as laid out below.

For the safety and wellbeing of everyone, it is imperative we all follow the Government Guidelines. Following the rules is not optional.

All members and guests entering the club MUST do the following:

Do not enter if you feel ill or have any symptoms of Covid 19, have been in close contact with anyone known to have Covid-19, or have returned from travelling out of country within the last 14 days.

- Put on a mask and enter the club through the front doors ONLY
 - If you do not have a mask then you can purchase one at the bar
- Use the hand sanitizer

- **Proceed to the Bar for sign in procedure**
- At the bar you will have your temperature taken by a staff member with a no touch thermometer
 - Please be patient – we are all getting used to the new way of doing things
 - After your temperature has been checked you will be approved to enter the club or asked to leave based on the temperature results.
 - No one will be served anything from the bar till you have signed in and had your temperature checked.
- Wear your mask when moving around the interior club common areas
 - Mask may only be removed only when seated at tables
- Tables are not to be moved.
- Wash your hands regularly
- Exit from the Patio door only

Anyone who does not follow the rules posted for distancing, wearing a mask and abiding by our signage – will be asked to follow them by our staff.

Note: The Pool Table is off limits until further notice.

Anyone who continues to disregard the Covid-19 protocols WILL BE REQUESTED TO LEAVE THE CLUB IMMEDIATELY.
