We had the privilege of hosting the USS San Diego and its LCU#1 landing craft at our club. We were on the news numerous times as you might have seen. Everyone associated with Fleet Week and the Disaster Response exercise Headed by the Port Authority was working at our club Sunday.: the USS San Diego, SF Port Authority, US Navy and Marines, SFPD, the Presidio Trust and many of their officers including, Us Navy Commander Jessia J O'brian. This years disaster response theme was " A major earthquake on the Hayward fault". Our club is the major land sea bridge in case the bay area bridges and the infrastructure go down. The S.F. Port Authority is in charge of coordinating all of these activities. There were three major days Involved, Sun, Wed and Monday. During these

days there were numerous landing craft operations on our ramp, including unloading and loading of trucks on the LCU.. The Navy and Marines gave us a life ring from the LCU#1craft and various other items were exchanged between the club and the military. Breakfast and/or lunch was served over the three days. I would like to thank John Mikulin for volunteering countless hours over the last few weeks and Alma Bishop for her hours in the kitchen to make this all happen. As you know the storm season is closing in on us fast. We are in the process of repairing and winterizing the dock and the club.
