EXPLORE GEORGIA

Language

Official language in Georgia is Georgian (Kartuli), whose spoken form has many dialects, usually divided into East Georgian and West Georgian groups. Georgian scripts were granted the national status of cultural heritage of Georgia in 2015 and inscribed on the UNESCO Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity in 2016.

There are just 14 independent scripts in the world and Georgian is one of them.

Currency

Georgian National currency is Georgian Lari (GEL). GEL 1 is equivalent to 100 tetri, and notes come in denominations of GEL 200, 100, 50, 20, 10, 5, 2 and 1. ATMs are common as is the use of credit cards.

Culture

In Georgia, you can discover our rich history, traditions, pride and friendship. This is a home to the earliest remains of modern man found outside of Africa, dated to be nearly 2 million years old. In Georgia you will discover a golden ancient history, churches and fortresses, cave towns,

Georgian polyphonic music and mesmerizing Georgian traditional dance.

A mix of two continents - Europe and Asia, and their diversity can be seen in the culture and architectural heritage of Georgia.

Adventure

During your stay, Georgia will delight you with a huge number of adventure tours. Getting away from busy life is easy in Georgia. Throughout the entire territory of Georgia, that you can explore by walking and trekking, paragliding, horseback riding, mountaineering, mountain biking, rafting, caving and seaside areas, natural world and national parks, etc.

There are 3 types of municipal transports operating in Tbilisi, such as: Bus, Mini Bus and Metro. In order to use the public transportation, you should obtain Metromoney card.

Weather

The climate in Tbilisi can be classified as moderately humid, subtropical. The average annual temperature in Tbilisi is 12.7 °C (54.9 °F). January is the coldest month with an average temperature of 0.9 °C (33.6 °F). July is the hottest month with an average temperature of 24.4 °C (75.9 °F).

SUPPORT SERVICES

The Office of Foreign Relations is the centralized contact point for all international – full degree and exchange – students. On one hand, the office administers student recruitment, enrollment and integration processes of degree seeking students, and on the other hand manages applications for incoming exchange students of partner universities.

Orientation – the Office of Foreign Relations provides a comprehensive orientation programme before the start of each academic semester. Orientation meeting involves the relevant representatives from the respective schools, department of student affairs, ESN and other related staff in your study process. During the orientation you will get familiar with the University academic and student life, practical information about living in Tbilisi and Georgia in general.


Health Insurance – before your arrival you will be advised about the health insurance companies you might choose after your arrival. There are different options and packages available for international

students. Health insurance is the obligatory for all degree seeking and exchange students visiting Ilia State University. See: <https://iliauni.edu.ge/en/international/student-life-services>

Immigration – all international students are supervised by the Office of Foreign Relations at ISU during the Visa and Residence Permit obtaining process. In some cases, citizens/residents coming from the specific countries can enter Georgia without a visa but if you don't belong these countries, you are required to apply for Long Term Visa (Immigration Visa, type D) for study purposes. After arrival, you should apply for Residence Permit to the Public Service Hall 40 calendar days prior to expiration of the term for your legal stay on the territory of Georgia. Accommodation – before your Arrival, Office of Foreign Relations provides the several housing options. After your arrival you will be able to sign the agreement with the landlord for a min. of 6 months or 1 year of stay.

ARGUS

Bachelor of Computer Engineering

The Bachelor's Degree Program in Computer Engineering at Ilia State University provides the student with the knowledge of the principles of digital computer operation. In today's world computers play significant role. Personal and server computers are their well know examples. Besides them, no lesser role is played by microcomputers, which control the operation of various devices and instruments. For example, mobile phones, digital cameras, television sets, washing machines, automobiles, medical instruments, airplanes, artificial satellites etc.

After completing the Bachelor's degree, a student can write software for microcontrollers and microprocessors, design and build medium-difficulty digital and hybrid circuits, as well as interface them with digital and analog sensors, and control devices.

Graduates can be expected to gain positions in the private or public sector in design or management positions of utility companies, municipalities, engineering consulting companies or the manufacturing and mining sector. There is a strong demand for qualified engineers and the salary growth is strong both locally and internationally while the local market is currently critically undersupplied and internship opportunities are currently being filled during the second year of studies on the San Diego State University joint degree operating in Tbilisi. There are also opportunities for graduates to continue their study abroad in San Diego or other international universities at a Master's or Doctorate level.

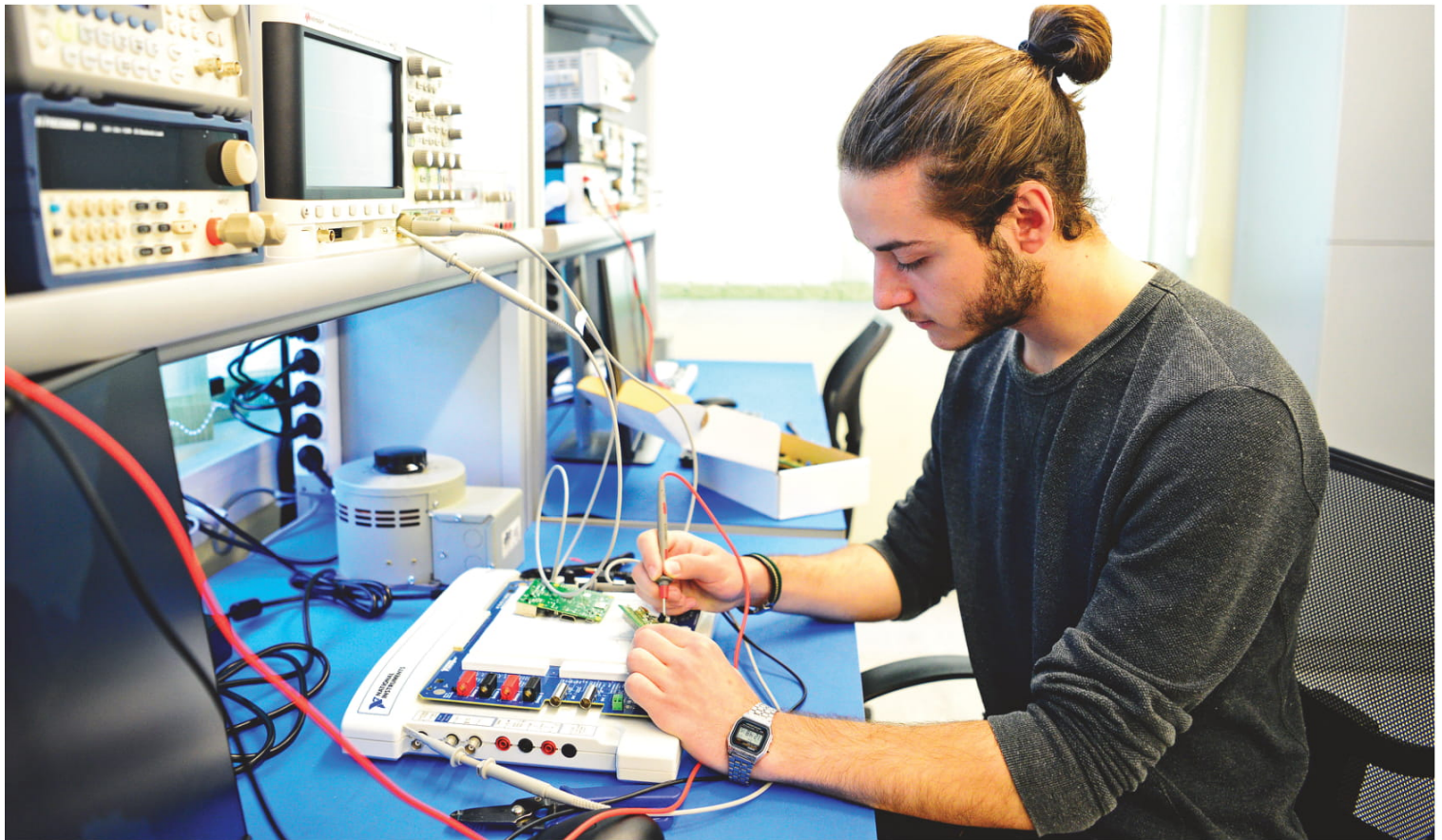

Within the framework of Erasmus+ joint programmes competition, the joint master's degree programme of the international consortium comprising 8 universities in Central and East European, Russian and Eurasian Studies (CEERES) has been funded.

Apart from Ilia State University, the consortium comprises the universities as follows: The University of Glasgow (Great Britain), The University of Tartu (Estonia), Corvinus University (Hungary), the Jagiellonian University (Poland), Kyiv-Mohyla Academy (Ukraine), Lobachevsky State University of Nizhni Novgorod (Russia), and KIMEP University (Kazakhstan).

The joint programme aims to produce professionals with modern and systematic knowledge on Central and Eastern Europe, Russia and Eurasia and particularly the Caucasus region who will manage to negotiate political, security and social-economic challenges in the region by applying modern approaches in the field and research methods.

- Master of Caucasian Studies, Ilia State University, Tbilisi, Georgia.

FOLLOW THE STEPS AND BECOME ISU STUDENT!

1. Choose your program. Please consider that Ilia State University runs up to 80 accredited programs on BA, MA and Ph.D. levels and only some of them are offered fully in English.
2. Check your eligibility and entry requirements. There are different eligibility criteria for each program.
3. Start your online application and upload requested documents.
4. Pay application fee and schedule the interview.
5. Receive for the preliminary approval from the respective school and letter on vacant places issued by the Rector.
6. Receive recognition letter issued by the National Centre for Educational Quality Enhancement and order on your enrollment issued by the Minister of Education, Science, Culture and Sport of Georgia.
7. Sign the contract and pay the tuition fee within 5 calendar days.
8. Receive the order on your enrollment and invitation letter.
9. Apply for Georgian visa (Immigration, type D) if necessary. Book your flight and share the flight details with the Office of Foreign Relations.
10. Attend the orientation meeting.
