WHAT IS SPECTACULAR ABOUT JUNETEENTH CULTURAL CELEBRATION

"Four Days of Juneteenth"

June teenth celebrates the unique culture of African Americans—and all Americans who embrace the emancipation of those once enslaved for profit. African Americans have thrived in creating many of the traditions that are now synonymous with American identity, particularly in the arts, including literature, music, fashion, and sports.

Juneteenth is not just an African American holiday-it is an American holiday. It celebrates culture, unity, triumph over evil, and national pride. Juneteenth is a cultural celebration for everyone.

The Spectacular Juneteenth Cultural Celebration was created by Councilman Gregory McLemore for the City of Franklin as part of a five-year plan to establish a national tourist destination in a county that played a significant role in both slavery and the emancipation that Juneteenth commemorates.

The June teenth Cultural Celebration is a multi-day event held in June, around the weekend of June 19th-the official June teenth holiday. This year marks the third year of the celebration. By design, it is meant to be larger, grander, and longer than any other June teenth celebration in Virginia, as we pursue our goal of creating a national tourist destination in Franklin/Southampton County-built on the

foundation of our rich emancipation history.

The theme for our third annual Juneteenth Cultural Celebration is "four Days of Juneteenth." In our first two years, the celebration lasted only three days. This year, as we expand, we also aim to present a new narrative surrounding one of Southampton's own-Nat Turner.

For over a century, Nat Turner-known worldwide-has been portrayed in a deeply negative light. Yet to millions of enslaved people, abolitionists, and descendants of the enslaved, he was seen as a freedom fighter and a hero.






























Honoring the Native Heroes of Southampton County, Virginia

Champions of Freedom, Justice, and Legacy, Southampton County, Virginia, holds sacred ground—a land shaped by resilience, defiance, and the unyielding pursuit of liberty. From the fields of revolt to the halls of legal battle, the region has birthed and harbored heroes whose legacies echo through the corridors of American history. This page honors five powerful figures: Nat Turner, Dred Scott, Anthony Gardener, John Brown, and James Magee—men whose lives and actions formed a tapestry of resistance, justice, and enduring truth.

Nat Turner (1800-1831)

Prophet. Rebel. Martyr.

Born into slavery in Southampton County, Nat Turner was a deeply spiritual man who claimed visions and signs from God. In 1831, he led one of the most significant slave uprisings in U.S. history—the Nat Turner Rebellion—fighting to free himself and others from bondage. Though the rebellion was ultimately suppressed, Turner's courage sparked intense national debate over slavery and ignited the flame of abolition. His life and sacrifice remain a haunting testament to the cost of freedom and the power of conviction.

Dred Scott (c. 1799-1858)

Symbol of Legal Injustice. Catalyst for Change.

Though most known for the infamous Dred Scott v. Sandford Supreme Court decision, Scott's early life traces back to Southampton County. Enslaved and denied basic human rights, he bravely pursued legal action for his freedom after being taken into free territories. The Court's 1857 ruling—that no Black person could be a U.S. citizen—outraged the nation and helped accelerate the path to the Civil War. Dred Scott's fight exposed the moral bankruptcy of slavery and the urgent need for justice.

Anthony Gardeneer (Dates Unknown)

Forgotten Patriot. Native Son.

Little documented but long remembered in local oral histories, Anthony Gardeneer is recognized as a native Black patriot of Southampton County. Stories speak of a man who resisted servitude and helped protect his community from violent retribution during the unrest of the 19th century. Though details of his life remain veiled by time, Gardeneer stands as a reminder that not all heroes are found in books—some live in the soul of the land and the memory of the people.

John Brown (1800-1859)

Abolitionist Warrior. Conscience of a Nation.

Though not born in Southampton County, John Brown was forever linked to its legacy. Inspired by Nat Turner's rebellion, Brown believed armed insurrection was the only path to abolish slavery. His 1859 raid on Harpers Ferry became a pivotal moment in American history. Brown revered Turner as a kindred spirit and often invoked Southampton's soil as sacred ground. He called for solidarity between races in the fight for freedom and died for that vision—a martyr to the cause of liberation.

James Magee (Dates Unknown)

Educator. Organizer. Hidden Hero.

James Magee, a lesser-known yet critical figure, worked tirelessly in postbellum Southampton to uplift the freed Black population through education and civic engagement. He helped establish schools and promoted literacy, believing knowledge was the key to long-term freedom. Magee's quiet leadership empowered generations to rise above oppression and reclaim their identity in a society still shadowed by racism.

Legacy in the Land

These men—rebels, thinkers, educators, and fighters—represent the spiritual and historical backbone of Southampton County. Their lives speak to universal themes of justice, resistance, and the indomitable will of a people who refused to be broken.



Nat Turner Story Tour

The Nat Turner Story tour is designed to take a shot at changing the traditional American narrative of a brutal killer to the reality of a man who gave his life trying to bring an end to the worst form of human slavery that civilization has ever known. Nat Turner born right here in Southampton County and is known throughout the entire world by most civilized and educated people for his 1831 insurrection and rebellion to emancipate and bring an end to the slavery of African American born slaves in the United States. The brutality and brutal acts he was accused of committing pales in comparison to the horrific acts of inhumanity and violence that was legalized against an entire race of people, whose sole existence was to serve and literally take care of. The most ironic portion of the American Nat Turner narrative is that he himself never actually killed anyone, his men and comrades did the killing under his command. If we refuse to correct the distorted inaccurate history now while we can the truth will remain untold and distorted. Another lie the American history narrative tells is the inaccurate description that he is portrayed as a dark skinned animalistic looking individual. In fact, he was what was referred to as a mulatto of mixed black and white race. The main thing that makes our Nat Turner Story Tour so unique and special is that there are 5 stops on the tour that are all hosted by direct descendants of Nat Turner's bloodline. All but one stop on the tour is on the exact land where Nat Turner was born, lived, hid out and traveled. A special event that makes our Juneteenth truly a cultural event and celebration unlike any other in the country. This event would not have been possible without the help and support of Ms. Shelly Lucas Wood, Khalifah Muhammad and the other blood descendants of the great Nat Turner.












Linwood's proudest accomplishment was undoubtedly his experience as a Montford Point Marine in the World War II, beginning on June 30th 1942, the Montford Point Marines were not trained in the traditional boot cams of Parris Island South Carolina, or San Diego, California instead, African American Recruits were segregated and experienced basic training at Montford Point, a newly established training area at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. Prefabricated, but dilapidated huts used as barracks were filled beyond capacity. Undeterred by such living conditions, the overt racism and segregation of the era, and surrounded by an air of constant doubt about their capabilities, these men, who would become known as the Mountford Point Marines, persevered and paved the way for those who followed. In 2012, the United States Congress authorized the congressional gold medal, the nation's highest civil award, to be awarded to each of the 200,000 Montford Point Marines.
