Here is a short examination of conscience that might be of assistance to you:

-Have I treated people, events, or things as more important than God? -Have my words, actively or passively, put down God, the Church, or people?

-Do I go to Mass every Sunday (or Saturday Vigil) and on Holy Days of Obligation

-Do I avoid, when possible, work that impedes worship to God, and joy for the Lord's Day?

-Do I show my parents due respect?

-Do I seek to maintain good communication with my parents where possible?

-Have I harmed another through physical, verbal, or emotional means, including gossip or manipulation of any kind?

-Have I respected the physical and sexual dignity of others and of myself? -Have I taken or wasted time or resources that belonged to another?

-Have I gossiped, told lies, or embellished stories at the expense of another?

-Have I honored my spouse with my full affection and exclusive love? -Am I content with my own means and needs, or do I compare myself to others unnecessarily?

## PARISHIONER CHRISTOPHER VOGT

BETHLEHEM – Passionate for the cause, Christopher Vogt, a parishioner of Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Church and son of the parish, has chaired the Measure Up Campaign for the Shelby Knights of Columbus since 2020.

Vogt is a member of Knights of Columbus Father Michael McFadden Council 1968. The Measure Up Campaign helps citizens with developmental disabilities and will be collecting donations around Shelby on April 4 and April 5 this year.

Collection Stations will be at Drug Mart, Gwirtz Market, Ace Hardware, Glen's Surplus and Sportsman's Den from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on April 4 and from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on April 5.

According to the Knights of Columbus Ohio State Council, "It is our 'FLAGSHIP' charity fundraiser conducted annually throughout the Great State of Ohio." https://kofcohio.org/

80% of the donated funds stay local.

"Traditionally around this area, the money goes to Richland New Hope," said Chris. "In the past, we divided funds" with Fairway/Waycraft in Crawford County.

The needs of the community are vast.

"There's highway clean-ups that we do four times a year," Vogt shared. "We clean the old MSC (Missionaries of the Sacred Heart) cemetery in the fall of leaves and sticks."

The cemetery is near the Abraxas campus on State Route 39.

Never one to shy away from commitment, "I joined the Knights of Columbus at 18-years-old," Vogt proudly said.

Membership is open to any male over the age of 18 that is a practicing Catholic.

The Shelby Knights of Columbus holds its meetings at 8:00 p.m. the second Tuesday of each month at 250 Vernon Road, Shelby.

Prayer is the cornerstone.

"We start our meetings with prayers," noted Vogt.

Members have a say where their donations are directed.

"We donate money to (Sacred Heart School), St. Mary's School, all kinds of charitable donations. It's a great thing to do," Vogt summed up.

Single men and those with families are welcome.

"When the kids were little – there's always a Christmas party – we would take the kids," Vogt reminisced. "Family picnics and such."

Vogt's wife, Christine, often accompanied her husband. Founders Day and community breakfasts were traditions, among others.

When a member passes away, widows are left in their wake.

"Knights of Columbus has life insurance," Vogt said, as a way to take care of the member's wife. "It's a great thing."

The Knights exist for the community in which its members live and worship.

"The Knights of Columbus is an awesome organization – Charitable. Fraternal," Vogt noted. It affords members "lots of ways to give back to others."
