As we soon celebrate the beginning of a new year, the Church places before us the gentle yet powerful Holy Day of "Mary, the Mother of God". This is no accident. The Lord gives us Mary at the start of each year to remind us that the Christian life always begins with receiving—receiving Christ and receiving God's help.

The Gospel for this solemnity describes Mary quietly pondering the shepherds' message in her heart. While the world celebrated noisily, Mary held the mystery of Christ with peace and attentiveness. She teaches us that the way forward in life is not through frantic activity or anxious planning, but through trust, prayer, and openness to God's will.

Let us kick off the New Year in prayer as Mary would by attending this Holy Day! The glorious Holy Day "Mary, the Mother of God" will be celebrated on Wednesday New Year's Eve @ Sacred Heart at 6:30pm and Thursday New Year's Day morning @ St. Joseph at 7:30am.

Mary is called—"God-bearer"—because she brought Christ into the world. But this title also says something about us: each of us is meant to carry Christ into our families, workplaces, and communities.

As we begin a new year may this feast day set us on the right track:

- May we, like Mary, listen for God's voice in the quiet moments.
- May we welcome Christ more deeply into our hearts.



Della Rae also had the honor of playing the role of the infant Jesus at our Nativity Play!


