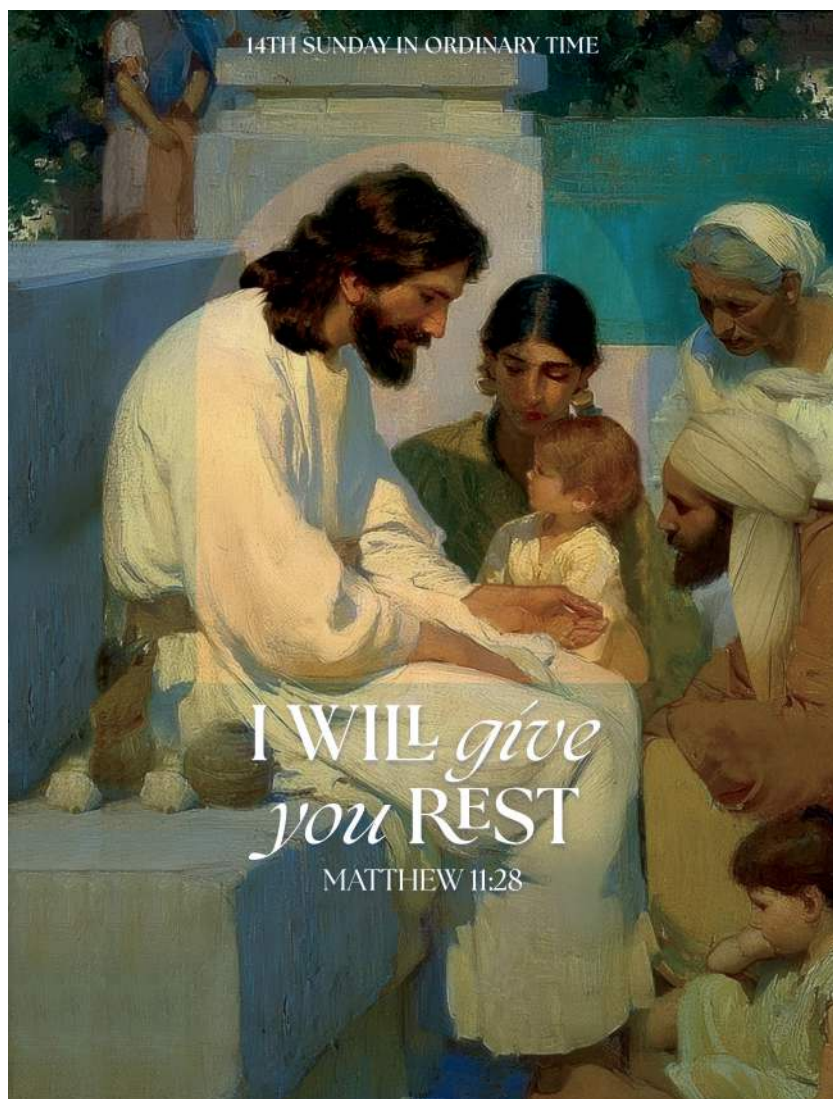

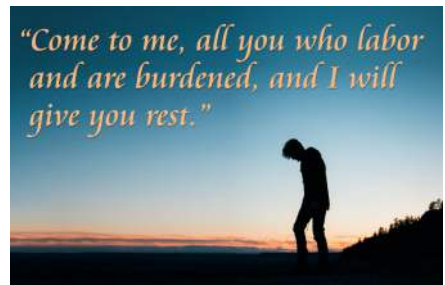

PARISHIONER REBEKAH WEBER

BETHLEHEM – Rebekah Weber has cultivated her ‘wild ones.’

The mother of three, Levi - seven, Lily - four, and Jack - two, along with her husband, Bob, has settled into the former home of Bob's grandparents, Hubert and Jane Metzger; Bob's mom is their daughter, Karen.

Growing up the daughter of Dave and Kathy Paynter, Rebekah was raised on a farm. Now living on the same property as Bob's grandparents, she has grown to appreciate flowers even more.

"I've seen pictures of his grandma's whole flower garden all around the house – flowers everywhere. I thought that was kind of special coming back here and bringing the flowers back to this property. It's a fun thing to do," Rebekah said.

Her mother-in-law, Karen, inspires her in the garden. "That's her job in Alabama at a Shakespeare's festival," working the grounds. "She's always in the garden."

Bob's aunt has been instrumental, as well.

"Deb Schumacher is just amazing. She does the flowers in church," added Rebekah.

Cody and Taylor Gosser offered to sell the house to Bob and Rebekah so that it would stay in Bob's family. "We would be stupid not to take it back in the family, so we moved here."

Having lived there now for three years, Rebekah recognized early on there was an open space in her yard along the line of trees where she could sprinkle seeds and let flowers grow wild.

"I just put different cut flowers out there," she said. With summers off since she's been the kindergarten teacher at Sacred Heart School for 12 years, "I like to get outside – especially having kids – it's a nice stress reliever to pick some weeds," she smiled.

As a daughter of the parish with a vested interest in the Heart of Bethlehem project, Rebekah serves on its committee.

"Hopefully, we can be out of the basement one day, but we just roll with it – we make do with what we have, we're not big complainers about this or that," Rebekah shared. "We have such a special school."

The business she now runs, Wild Ones Flower Farm, started at Spots Rolling Bean in Crestline three years ago. "I asked them that first year, 'do you mind if I bring up bouquets and sell them here?'" Rebekah shared.

She relies on word of mouth, which then led to her subscription service in its second year.

"Seven or eight ladies bought a flower subscription," Rebecca noted. Every Saturday for five weeks, "I would either deliver flowers to their house or they would come pick them up. That worked because I knew how many I needed."

Now in her third year, the flowers are starting to grow after a rainy spring. Parishioners and locals are invited to contact Rebekah and place their orders.

"I named it the Wild Ones Flower Farm because I have three crazy kids," Rebekah laughed. "Wildflowers – wild kids, crazy kids. My kids keep me busy, but I also need to be outside."

Flowers are a source of comfort.

"I just like how flowers bring joy to people and bring happiness. The kids – the older they get, they like to help," Rebekah added.

"I have to keep the boys from running through the flowers or shoveling up the flowers – right, Jack?," she asked her mischievously grinning son.

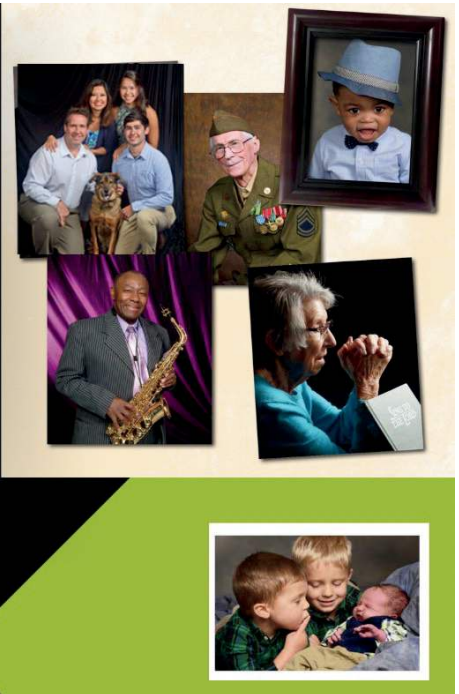

Letter From the Principal

Why not enroll at Sacred Heart School? Families have many reasons for choosing a partnership with Sacred Heart School. Some of the reoccurring reasons are: living/learning about our Catholic faith and strong academics. We are a community of Faith, Knowledge, and Service. We also have the resources to provide an Intervention Specialist, Title I Services, Speech Therapist, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy and Counseling.

We offer many scholarship opportunities! Sacred Heart School can be an affordable choice for any family. We are a provider for EdChoice Scholarship. Currently this scholarship is potentially available to families that live in the **Crestline School district**. The Jon Peterson Scholarship which is for students who are currently on an IEP. We are also a provider for the EdChoice Expansion Scholarship which is available for families who meet certain income guidelines. We also offer the One Faith Many Blessings Scholarship available to families that may need tuition assistance to attend our school.

Our community of Faith, Knowledge and Service keeps evolving with the times while keeping a secure belief of our past. We are currently accepting registration for the 26/27 school year for students in third -eighth grades. Our 3-year-old preschool – second grade classes are full.
