- 2.) We will have a banner with all their names written upon it as well in remembrance of them.
- 3.) Also we will have candles at the side altar to represent the light of Christ in the deceased.

(These candles will be lit during Mass times)

What a neat opportunity to celebrate All Souls Day at our Sunday liturgies. This is very uncommon to have this Mass on a Sunday. So uncommon that I bet in my 6 times celebrating All Souls at our parishes ... many have probably never witnessed me wear my black vestments. They are certainly my cleanest and smoothest vestments as I only wear them once a year. lol


