### Who was Mary Magdalene? "Apostle of the Apostles"

Patron Saint of Repentant Sinners, Hairdressers, Perfumeries, Contemplative Life. We recognize her faith and devotion on July 22nd.

In Catholic theology, Mary Magdalene is revered as a devoted follower of Jesus Christ and a symbol of repentance and redemption. She is mentioned in all four Gospels as one of the women who accompanied Jesus and supported his ministry. According to Luke 8:2, Jesus cast seven demons out of her, signifying her profound transformation. Catholic tradition holds that she was at the foot of the cross and witnessed Jesus' crucifixion and burial. Read Mt 27:56, Mk 15:40, Lk 23:49, and Jn 19:25. She was the first to see the risen Christ as noted in Jn 20:11-18, making her the "apostle to the apostles". For centuries she was mistakenly conflated with a repentant sinful woman in Luke 7, often identified as a former prostitute, though this view has been re-evaluated in modern times.

The story of Mary Magdalene reminds us all of a fundamental truth. A disciple of Christ is one who, in the experience of human weakness, has the humility to ask for His help, has been healed by Him, and set out following closely after Him, becoming a witness of the power of His merciful love that is stronger than sin and death.
