

## September 09, 2025 PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES

In attendance: Father Jeff, Lisa Myers, Austin Markwell, Doug Lucius, Jacob Rietschlin, Joe DiLulo, Greg Keller & Heath Gwirtz, Jacob Gosser, Taylor Gosser, Justin Tuttle, & Seth Rietschlin (guest).

Father Jeff opened with a prayer.

Joe DiLulo read the minutes.

Doug Lucius made a motion to accept the September 9th, 2025 meeting minutes and Jacob Rietschlin seconded the motion.

### Father Jeff's Report:

- Seth Rietschlin was available for any questions regarding the Heart of Bethlehem survey for the campus expansion. He advised that the purpose of the survey was to determine interest and asked all to urge others to take the survey so the team has a better understanding of the will of the parish. Seth noted that of the responses so far, there was significant support for question #1: are you satisfied with the renovations that have been completed in the last 3 years and support for question #2: do you support a campus expansion that would involve relocated Kindergarten and Preschool from the basement, removing the mobile unit, and enhancing restroom facilities. Seth noted that 14% responded no to question #3: do you support the relocation of the parish office into the school addition. Discussion revealed that cost is a big factor in the support for the project.
- Fr. Jeff shared a sample directory and proposed combining with St. Joe. There was unanimous support therefore Fr. Jeff and Greg Keller to work on details
  Discussion about announcement from the bishop concerning the end of gun raffles and the turkey shoot. It was decided that the turkey shoot does not sell guns or accept money from the sale of firearms and therefore should continue until told otherwise. The gun raffle may continue as a raffle for gift cards in lieu of guns.

### Principals Report:

- Recently had the Ignatius book store which was a success
- Children are preparing for the Christmas nativity program
   Trying to encourage everyone to take advantage of the state tax return program to benefit the school

## Old Business:

- Doug Lucius gave update that the center doors on the front of the church will need to be locked manually because of their construction, but the side doors can be on timers.
  - Heath Gwirtz is getting a quote to pave the rest of the parking lot

## New Business:

- The locks on the main gym doors are loose
  - Door between gym and storage room is jammed
  - Downspout on the gym is leaking
  - Microphone from the gym is missing

Greg Keller made a motion to adjourn and Doug Lucius seconded the motion

Father closed with a prayer.

Next meeting will be held January 13th after 6:30 mass in the Parish Office
