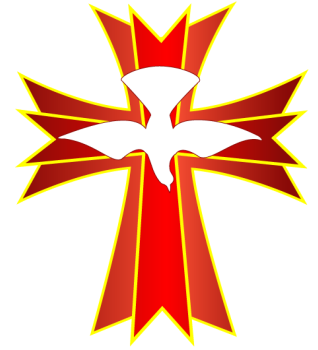

Greetings Parishioners,

When I first arrived here it was with a heavy heart that I announced via bulletin that a priest in the Diocese of Toledo was accused of sexual abuse. Not to reopen wounds but I believe it is necessary to share that the trial of this priest concluded recently. Mike Zacharias, 56, was found guilty of all five counts of sex trafficking, two of which involved victims who were minors. The allegations spanned 15 years, from July 2005 to August 2020. Once again, I share this information not to reopen wounds of those who knew Mike Zacharias while he served in Mansfield nor to put that sick feeling in your stomach that comes from the thoughts of the crimes that Mike Zacharias was found guilty. Rather, this article is written to simply be transparent about what is getting a lot of press up north in Toledo and to update you on the ruling.

Another important reason I share this is to give me an opportunity to share publicly how the Diocese suggests we report abuse especially of minors in The Diocese of Toledo Safe Environment Program. Here is how to go about it:

Each year, the Diocese of Toledo is required to undergo an audit to ensure it is in compliance with the articles of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. This year's audit examined the audit period of July 1st, 2018 through September 30, 2021. Bishop Thomas is pleased to announce that the Diocese was found to be in full compliance with the requirements in the Charter following the audit. The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people.

If you have any knowledge of abuse that has been committed by a cleric or by any personnel of the Catholic Church, you are urged to report the abuse to your local police department, Children Services, and to contact the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at 419-214-4880; or to write to the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at 1933 Spielbusch Avenue, Toledo, Ohio 43604.

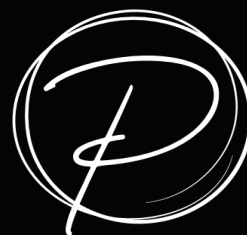
