Dear Parishioners,

During Lent we acknowledge the ways we have turned away from God in our lives. We should focus on turning our hearts and minds back towards God. We can turn back to God by **praying**, **fasting**, and **almsgiving**. These observances help us turn away from whatever has distracted us and turn back to God.

Lent lasts for forty days because that's how long Jesus wandered in the desert, fasting, while he resisted Satan's temptations. During the forty days of Lent, we are trying to be like Jesus. We can resist temptations and use this time to become closer to God. Lent isn't simply a "countdown" or something to "get through". It is a chance to set aside distractions and focus on our relationship with the Lord.

Prayer gives us the time to have a meaningful conversation with God. It also gives us time to reflect on our thoughts and actions and work on becoming closer to God.

We **fast** because giving up something for Lent is ultimately a form of fasting. We can deprive ourselves of some small pleasure and offer that sacrifice up to God. We might "give up" a bad habit so we can positively turn our life aback toward what God wants for us. We are not only fasting from food and drink, but also from

gossip, jealousy and anger.

We practice **almsgiving** during Lent as an opportunity to make a greater effort to see Christ in the poor, the suffering, and the marginalized.

During this season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, we are working towards building a better relationship with God and our brothers and sisters. During this Lenten Season we have the opportunity to reflect on our own attitude towards others. Sometimes we might need reminded that we are all made in Christ's image. What a better way to prepare ourselves for the risen Lord by returning our hearts and minds back to God.

Dispensation from Abstinence March 17th.

Out of pastoral solicitude, Bishop Daniel Thomas has dispensed the faithful of the Diocese of Toledo, whether actually present in the territory or not, from the obligation to abstain from meat on the memorial of St. Patrick, Bishop, which will be observed this year on Friday, March 17th. Catholics present in the Diocese of Toledo who otherwise reside in another diocese, are likewise dispensed. No member of the faithful is required to make use of this dispensation. Those who choose to make use of the dispensation are strongly encouraged to abstain from meat on some other day that week as part of their penitential practices during Lent. In this way, a faithful Catholic still keeps the penitential spirit of a Friday in Lent and unites oneself more closely with the suffering Christ and His Church.
