St. Catherine of Siena, born in 1347 in Italy, the youngest of 25 children, was a mystic, activist, and author. She consecrated her virginity to Christ at a very young age and experienced mystical visions. In 1363 she took simple vows, which allowed her to remain outside a convent, and joined the Sisters of Penitence. Despite being uneducated, she had a profound impact on the Catholic Church and society. Known for her spiritual visions and dedication to serving the poor and sick, she played a crucial role in the reform of the Church during the 14th. Century. Catherine corresponded with popes and political leaders, urging peace and reconciliation. She was later canonized as a saint and one of only 4 women ever declared a Doctor of the Church for her wisdom and writings. Meaning her writings (all dictated) have special authority in Roman Catholicism. She was also declared Patron Saint of Europe and Italy. Catherine of Siena died in 1380 at the age of 33. Her feast day is April 29th.

Everything we know about St. Joseph comes from the Bible; first appearing in the gospels of Matthew and Luke. In addition to being the spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the foster-father of Jesus, St Joseph was a carpenter. The life of St. Joseph shows us the dignity of human work. Through manual labor, Joseph found contentment in providing for the Holy Family, and shared in the divine plan of salvation. Jesus is often referred to as "the son of the carpenter". Circumstances of his death are unknown but it is implied that he died before the crucifixion (John 19:26-27). His feast day was officially instituted by Pope Pius XII on May 1, 1955, in order to ensure that workers not lose this Christian understanding of work; but earlier Popes had already prepared the groundwork. Blessed Pius IX had recognized the importance of St. Joseph as a laborer when he proclaimed him Patron of the Universal Church.

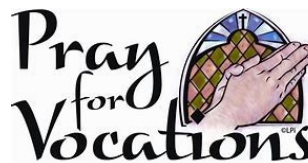
Accepting enrollment for the 2024/2025 school year Sacred Heart School
