With both schools being out for summer soon comes some extra time for me to give some much needed service to the people in the pews. With this in mind I'm excited to announce that I will be leading 2 summer book studies. One for women and possibly one for men! For the women's book club we will be meeting every other Tuesday for an hour from 5pm until 6pm to discuss chapters from a given book. Our first book is "Made for Love, Loved by God" by Father Peter John Cameron. This book is inspirational and helpful for those who once again wish to find intimacy or increase intimacy with our Lord. The book is a down-toearth, practical reflection on the nature of God's love, eloquently written by Fr. Peter Cameron. Drawing heavily on Sacred Scripture and the transforming encounters with Jesus Christ recorded in the Gospels. Fr. Cameron seeks to make God's love as real, concrete, and accessible to his readers' lives as possible. He emphasizes how God constantly searches for us and takes the initiative in loving us—how he woos us into happiness with him if we are open to it.... and even sometimes when we are not open to it!

"Made for Love, Loved by God" will also address common misconceptions about God' s love as well as the obstacles that prevent us from letting God love us. After reading this book, the reader will feel closer to God by being shown a way to be closer to God. It will imbue the reader with the certainty of the psalmist: " The Lord delights in those who wait for his love" (Psalm 147:11).

I look forward to this book study and possibly a book study with the guys as well. If any men want me to lead a book study for them ... I WILL BE MORE than happy to do so!!! I have heard some guys say they would like the idea of a book club... but I'm looking for a little more certainty in participating rather than a wishy washy desire. Fellas JUST LET ME KNOW if you are serious about a little book study of our own. Then I will pick out a book for the guys to study as well.
