Greetings prayer warriors,

Thank you for all your prayers for my father. Each day he is getting a little bit better. He is still in the hospital and not out of the woods yet. But since so many of you have been praying for him I would like to give you an update.

Dad is now off of the ventilator and is breathing on his own. Also at this point his blood is free from sepsis and the blood clot in his lung has dissolved. Some may say that he is very lucky but I know that he is doing well because of the many prayers sent his way by you!

At this point he is still at Lima St. Rita's hospital doing physical therapy. He was on the vent for close to 2 weeks as they were pumping him full of antibiotics due to the underlying cause of everything in his pancreas. Being unable to move for 2 weeks has seriously weakened his muscles as they were not getting their regular exercise in everyday movement. But, this next week he will be putting in 2 hours each day of physical therapy to get his muscles strong again. He hopes to make it to the Sacred Heart festival in a couple weeks to give his thanks to everyone for their prayers. This goal is really pushing it though, so don't expect to see him this year at the festival. Rather a more realistic goal is everyone catching him at the Crestline Harvest festival in the early fall.

Thanks for the many prayers and continue to pray for all of our parishioners in need. There are a good amount of us currently going through treatments and physical frustrations each day! "Jesus divine physician... help them!"
