Greetings Parishioners,

This Advent and Christmas season I will be having a book study on the Mass. We will be meeting at Sacred Heart's parish office if the group is small or Sacred Heart's gym if the group is large. We will discuss the first half of the book Wednesday Dec 14th from 6:30pm-8pm and the second half Wednesday January 11th from 6:30pm-8pm.

The book is called "What Nobody Ever Told Us: A Guide to Getting More Out of the Catholic Mass". To summarize the book I would say that the book is an accessible, but theologically and biblically rich, guide to active participation in the Mass. Father Phil Smith takes a play -by-play approach to unpacking the Mass, making the ancient liturgical rituals come alive for the contemporary reader. Regular Mass goers will appreciate this book, as it explains many details of the Mass that average Catholics have never learned. This book will also be a huge help to those who attend Mass infrequently, struggle to stay engaged during the Mass, or are new to the Mass and Catholicism.

The author Fr. Phil Smith is a good friend of mine. We both grew up in Tiffin OH and he was a great inspiration for me to become a priest. Although we are about the same age, from the same town, and have the same last name... we are NOT related. He was 3 years ahead of me in school. Fr. Phil went to the Catholic School Calvert and I went to the public school Hopewell Loudon. Father Phil Smith is a priest of the Diocese of Toledo. He earned a BA in catechetics, theology, and philosophy from Franciscan University of Steubenville. He completed graduate degrees at the Pontifical Gregorian University and the Pontifical John Paul II Institute for Studies on Marriage and Family in Rome. He has ministered at several parishes in the Diocese of Toledo, including five years at Corpus Christi University Parish at The University of Toledo where he was also Director of the Christian Leadership Program. He currently serves as a Pastor of a parish and as the Director of the Office for Diocesan Priestly Vocations.
