Dear Parishioners,

Here are some questions I was asked after last week's Living Christ Campaign announcement:

1. How do you come up with the amount of money to ask from each household?

It is based off past giving.

2. Does everyone get a home visit?

Fr. Jeff or one of his team members are required to offer a home visit to the top 43% of givers in the parish. **But ... everyone has the opportunity to receive a home visit.** Simply ask Fr. Jeff and he will GLADLY visit your home.

3. I wasn't offered a home visit. Does that mean Fr. Jeff does not want my support?

Fr. Jeff still desires your involvement in the Living Christ Campaign and he will send a letter to each household who did not receive a visit. If you want a home visit just call Fr. Jeff's cell phone at 567-207-6382.

4. Now that we reached our goal at both parishes what is the point of the campaign going until December?

Fr. Jeff still has plenty of homes to visit and everyone should have the opportunity to hear the goodness that the campaign offers. Also, now that we have reached goal ... the parish gets 50% of all donations from here on out rather than only 35%.

I will continue to answer any questions sent my way via the bulletin so everyone can know the details of the campaign that I did not present accurately or clearly during last weekend's Masses.
