This year's audit examined the audit period of July 1, 2018 through September 30, 2021. Bishop Daniel Thomas is pleased to announce that the Diocese was found to be in full compliance with the requirements in the Charter following the audit. The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people.
