Together, our diocese has boldly decided to take responsibility for the mission and future of the Church by fostering holy disciples, holy families, and holy vocations. As you may have heard after years of careful prayer, planning and discernment, our diocese has launched a major diocesan wide campaign called "Living Christ". I am so pleased that St. Joseph parish is around 98% of our goal and Sacred Heart at around 82% of our Diocesan Living Christ goal. We are doing so well in raising funds for our Diocese and I am extremely thankful especially to those courageous parishioners who have helped me make home visits. I AM SO PROUD!

I will always accept another Living Christ Campaign helper as we begin to speak more about the campaign next weekend since many of our families have returned from their vacation homes after Labor Day.
