Some of the reoccurring reasons are: living/learning about our Catholic faith and strong academics. We are a community of Faith, Knowledge, and Service. Each one of those aspects is important by themselves. But, more importantly, living them out all together is life- changing. Living out Faith, Knowledge and Service is ingrained in our daily curriculum at Sacred Heart School.

At Sacred Heart School we focus on building a relationship with God and we provide strong academics. At Sacred Heart School, we are learning about our Catholic faith. As a community, celebrate Mass together. As a school community, we pray together. We pay reverence to our feast days, holy days of obligation, learning more about our faith during religion classes, learning more about our faith by having conversations with other believers, and participating in Advent, Lenten and sacramental retreats. We are blessed by being able to put our faith in action daily.

We also provide strong academics! Our students reap the benefits of being in smaller classrooms. They are able to have more one on more time. All of our teachers are State certified through ODE. Eighty five % of our staff have their Master's Degree. We also have aids in the classrooms for grades 3-year-old preschool – sixth grades. Our 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students are given many opportunities being leaders of our school. They are also able to mature into the person God is calling them to be in a nurturing environment.

Also, our  $8^{th}$  grade students also have the opportunity to take Algebra I for high school credit their  $8^{th}$  grade year. For the 24/25 school year all of our students who took Algebra I for high school credit passed the State of Ohio High School Exam. We even had two students test into high school honors geometry class.

All of our students take MAP testing to help ensure that they are reaching bench marks throughout the school year. By having smaller classes, we are able to offer intervention to students that might need extra help. We also have the resources to provide an Intervention Specialist, Title I Services, Speech Therapist, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy and Concealing.

We offer many scholarship opportunities! Sacred Heart School can be an affordable choice for any family. We are a provider for EdChoice Scholarship. Currently this scholarship is potentially available to families that live in in the Crestline School district. The Jon Peterson Scholarship which is for students who are currently on an IEP. We are also a provider for the EdChoice Expansion Scholarship which is available for families who meet certain income guidelines. We also offered the One Faith Many Blessings Scholarship which is available to families that may need tuition assistance to attend our school.

Our community of Faith, Knowledge and Service keeps evolving with the times while keeping a secure belief of our past. We are currently accepting registration for the 25/26 school year for students first-eighth grades. Our 3-year-old preschool – kindergarten classes are full. ### PARISHIONER ADAM SCHROEDER

BETHLEHEM - The fourth Sunday in July is around the corner, so the annual festival is nearly upon us. This year's chairman, Adam Schroeder, has fond memories of Sacred Heart School's largest fundraiser.

"When you think about the festival," Adam recalled, "it's hard not to think about your childhood - running around, playing games with your friends."

The festival starts at 11 a.m. Food often sells out, so guests are invited to come early.

"Everyone that comes around always loves the chicken dinners -It's hard to beat those," Adam noted.

As a son of the parish, "I was the 'spray boy' for the chicken dinners," said Adam. "For years, I made the spray. It was always fun to be the kid that was with all the adults spraying the chicken and making the spray."

The spray is put on the chicken every time they're flipped.

"It's been the tradition of how they're made for decades. It's a secret, secret sauce," Adam firmly shared.

Every year, there was a friendly battle to make it to the parish grounds first on Festival Day. Growing up, Adam and his brothers, along with their dad, Paul Schroeder, would wake up early.

"We'd go down and try to beat Rusty Keller so we could light the fire," Adam said with a smile. "If we got to the train tracks and saw a big explosion, we knew Rusty beat us."

The Schroeders would arrive between 5 - 5:30 a.m.

In its 132nd year, "the festival runs itself," Adam shared. "We've got a lot of people that have always done a good job and continue to do great jobs."

The festival is well-orchestrated through its generations of parishioners and new parishioners, alike. "It's nice to let the people do what they need to do," noted Adam.

Kids' games are always a hit and this year will include something new for the older ones - gaga ball. "We'll give it a shot and see how it goes," said Adam.

Adam and his wife, Samantha, a daughter of the parish, lived away from The Settlement for almost 10 years. After attending college at Shawnee State University, they both worked in southern Ohio for six years. They missed the rhythms of parish life.

"Very glad to be back," Adam emphasized. "Being away and moving home, it's pretty easy to see God everywhere in The Settlement. You see the people that put all this time and effort into something that they don't own, but we all own together."


Skilled in woodworking, Adam learned the trade from his father.


"There is something satisfying about building with your own hands," Adam proudly shared. "I hope that I can keep it up and pass it down to my kids."
