Dear Parishioners,

As we start a new year, I wanted to thank you for your support of Sacred Heart School! Each year we celebrate the gift of attending Sacred Heart School during Catholic School's Week during the last week in January. As you know, the gift of a Catholic education is not contained in just one week of celebration.

One way you can support Catholic education at Sacred Heart School is by donating to: Heart School's SGO account with the Diocese of Toledo. It is very simple to donate and there is **NO** cost to you! As Ohioans, we are eligible to donate up to \$750.00 (or \$1,500.00 for those who are married filing jointly) to a Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) that in turn will provide a tax credit to the donor based on one's tax liability. While you cannot claim more than your total tax liability, as long as you owe at least \$750.00 (or \$1,500.00) on your Ohio taxes, you can donate up to the full amount and receive an equivalent amount as a credit on your State of Ohio tax return. **In 2024, \$19,000 was donated to Sacred Heart School. Thank you for your generosity! We were able to help 22 families with your donations.**

Donations received prior to April 15th, 2026 can be applied to the 2025 tax year.

An acknowledgment letter will be mailed to you for tax credit purposes.

The initials of the Magi are separated by crosses and the year. The initials also stand for the words "Christus Mansionem Benedicat" which means "May Christ Bless this house". The Epiphany House Blessing and blessed chalk are available to take home and can be found in the back of church on the registers.

Blessing of Home and Household on Epiphany

Inscribe the following with the blessed chalk over the door entering your house:

20 + C + M + B + 26

When all have gathered, a suitable song may be sung. The leader makes the sign of the cross, and all reply, "Amen."

The leader greets those present in the following words:

Let us praise God, who fills our hearts and homes with peace. Blessed be God forever.
R/. Blessed be God forever.

In the following or similar words, the leader prepares those present for the blessing:

The Word became flesh and made His dwelling place among us. It is Christ who enlightens our hearts and homes with His love. May all who enter this home find Christ's light and love.

One of those present or the leader reads a text of sacred Scripture, for example, Luke 19:1-9.

The intercessions are then said – the response to each is "Stay with us, Lord".

Leader: The Son of God made his home among us. With thanks and praise let us call upon him.

Leader: Lord Jesus Christ, with Mary and Joseph you formed the Holy Family: remain in our home, that we may know you as our guest and honor you as our Head. We pray...

Leader: Lord Jesus Christ, you had no place to lay your head, but in the spirit of poverty accepted the hospitality of your friends: grant that through our help the homeless may obtain proper housing. We pray...

Leader: Lord Jesus Christ, the three kings presented their gifts to you in praise and adoration: grant that those living in this house may use their talents and abilities to your greater glory. We pray...

After the intercessions the leader invites all present to say the Lord's Prayer.

The leader says the prayer of blessing with hands joined:

Lord God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only-begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who inhabit it. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our concern for others may reflect your love.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.

R/. Amen.

The leader concludes the rite by signing himself or herself with the sign of the cross and saying: May Christ Jesus dwell with us, keep us from all harm, and make us one in mind and heart, now and forever.

R/. Amen.

It is preferable to end the celebration with a suitable song, for example, "O Come, All Ye Faithful" or "We Three Kings."

A Catholic View to Resolutions

Catholics view New Year's resolutions as great opportunities for spiritual growth, focusing less on worldly goals and more on drawing closer to God through prayer, sacraments, acts of mercy, scripture study, and virtue development, often by integrating specific Catholic practices like monthly fasting or devotion to a saint into the new year, making it a time for deeper conversion, not just self-improvement.

Key Catholic Resolutions

- **Sacramental Life:** Attend Mass more regularly (daily if possible), go to Confession, and focus on receiving grace.
- **Prayer:** Start or deepen a prayer routine, like the Morning Offering, Daily Examen, or Rosary, and reflect on the daily Scripture readings.
- **Works of Mercy:** Commit to feeding the hungry, visiting the sick, comforting the lonely, or giving to the poor.
- **Spiritual Disciplines:** Practice fasting, give up gossip, learn about a new saint each month, or learn more about your faith through educational resources like FORMED.org.
- **Forgiveness:** Actively seek reconciliation with enemies or alienated family members.

Catholic Approach to Resolutions

- **Humility:** Acknowledge past failures and accept God's forgiveness through confession.
- **Focus on God:** Resolutions should aim for holiness and mission, not just worldly achievement.
- **Specifics:** Start with clear, actionable goals (e.g., "Pray the Rosary every Tuesday").
- **Integration:** Weave resolutions into your daily Catholic life, not just as a separate task.
