Diocese of Toledo Priest Ordination

Join us in joyful gratitude as we welcome Father Andrew Messer, the newest priest of the Diocese of Toledo, who was ordained to the transitional diaconate on Saturday, June 27th

A message from Father Andrew Messer:

My home parish is St. Joan of Arc in Toledo. I grew up with the sacraments, but didn't attend church regularly till my first year of college at the University of Toledo. I attended Springfield Local Schools, where I had a love for science. Studying Physics, with a concentration in Astrophysics at Toledo, I came to the profound understanding of God as the creator of the universe and wanted to give my life completely to Him after reading though the Gospels the first time. If I was going to dedicate to the stars, why not go deeper still and hand it over to the maker of it all. My faith journey after high school was marked by a series of tragedies that I consider essential to my strong faith and trust in the Lord. I owe my faith and vocation to my grandma, Joan Schmenk, who took me to church during the last years of her life. After exploring other possible vocations throughout college, I formally considered a vocation after a conversation with my priest, Fr. Phil Smith, after he became a vocation director and encouraged me to pray about it.

The community at Toledo truly gave me a firm identity, and serving Mass for the Sisters of the Visitation taught me what I know about spiritual life. Learning how to be gentle with myself and humble before God, I found my true devotion to Mary and to the Sacred Heart. After studying at Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit, MI for two years, I was asked to study at the North American College in Rome. Life with Jesus is a great adventure! Though life can get complicated, I know He is in charge and always forming my heart to be more like His. As I approach ordination to the Order of Presbyter, I ask for your prayers and specifically that I be more a man after His own heart.
