2) **High School Scholarship** (\$1000.00) is offered to a student graduating from one of the following area high schools: Colonial Heights, Matoaca, or Thomas Dale. Subject line must contain **ALA 284 - 2023-2024 scholarship application** along with the **scholarship name** you are applying for. Regular mail or hand delivered applications will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
