OUTREACH

My Brother's Table serves a hot meal to all who come to Trinity's Parish Hall on Sundays between 1:30 and 2:30 pm. Between 30 and 60 people are served every Sunday, plus second helpings for all who desire them. Take-home food bags are also distributed.

Our Gathering Place reaches out to high school youth each day as part of an afterschool program. Students get snacks and can stay and play pool or other games, study and listen to music in a safe environment. Parents appreciate the program knowing their child has somewhere to stay until they pick them up or the adults can get home.
