## From Rev. Haydie

It'll be here before we know it: Lent, the church's season of reflection, repentance, and re-centering. Of recommitting ourselves to the things that matter most. Of reclaiming hope and preparing our hearts for the joy of Easter morning.

But first, we party! We'll celebrate **Mardi Gras** at **6pm on Tuesday, February 17**. We'll come together in the Parish Hall for a festive supper of pancakes, sausage, and more. There will be masks and beads, good food and good company.

Traditionally called "Shrove Tuesday" by Anglicans, this celebration offers us a chance to celebrate our blessings before setting a few of them aside for a while.

Our Lenten season itself will begin at **7pm on Ash Wednesday, February 18**, with the traditional service of communion and the imposition of ashes. On that night, we'll admit that we come to God mourning and poor in spirit, dismayed by the frailties of our lives and our world. We'll admit how powerless we feel. How hopeless our hunger for righteousness can seem. And then we'll come to God's table, where we'll be reminded that we are, indeed, blessed and forgiven. That we and all we care for are held in God's loving hands.

As Lent continues, we'll keep coming together. We'll continue our regular First Friday Concert-and-Compline series: mark your calendars now for this month's event on February 6! But we'll also add a series of Lenten **Soup Suppers** at 6pm on alternate Tuesdays: that is, on **February 24, March 10, and March 24**. At 7pm, after we've eaten, we'll move to the church for the short and lovely candlelit service of Sung Compline.

May yours be a blessed and holy Lent.

## Annual Meeting

Trinity's Annual Meeting on January 25 was not only cheerful but relatively brief—excellent qualities in almost any meeting! If you missed it, copies of the Annual Report are still available in the church office. The report includes the annual budget.

Congregants chosen for new roles included Kathleen Kangas and Roberta Turner, each elected to a three-year term on vestry; Susan Goslee, elected to a three year term on the Planned Giving Committee; and Timothy Cole and Scott Bouman, elected as delegate and alternate, respectively, to the Diocese of Idaho's 2026 Convention. Outgoing vestry members were recognized for their service over the last three years, as was outgoing Senior Warden Muffy Lane.

Trinity's Senior Warden for 2026 will be Diane Nelson, who brings a wealth of experience to the task. Diane filled this position faithfully and effectively during several of the years when Trinity didn't have a priest. More recently she's served on vestry and the Planned Giving Committee. She's built and managed each year's budget while keeping track of Trinity's investment accounts and more.

The Senior Warden is the lay leader of any Episcopal congregation. He or she is appointed by the priest and is the first person the priest turns to for perspective, guidance and help. That appointment can be renewed for a second or third year, but it doesn't have to be. Right now, we're just grateful to have Diane as Senior Warden for *this* year!



## Weavers

Episcopal Church Weavers (ECW) met January 24th in the parish hall. We discussed the possibility of having a rummage sale this summer since it is such a good fundraiser. A decision will be made at our February meeting. We will also prepare the bags for Midterm Care Packages in February because midterm bags need filled on March 1. We gave \$500 to Rev. Diane to meet needs of the Trans population at Pocatello Women's Correctional Center. Rev. Diane will communicate with the prison volunteer coordinator to determine the exact items currently needed and purchase them.

Much of our time was spent planning for Lenten and Easter week activities. We planned a Mardi Gras Pancake Supper on Shrove Tuesday, February 17, at 6:00 pm. During Lent there will be sung Compline services every other Tuesday evening at 7:00 pm. We will host Soup Suppers in the parish hall at 6:00 pm prior to those Compline services. We will also be hosting a meal at 6:00 pm on Maundy Thursday, April 2. After the meal, Rev. Haydie will serve Communion at our dinner table. Then we will all go over to the church for a short service which will include stripping the altar.


