Miffy's Message

Staying informed is one of the most important things that you can do as a community member. Portneuf Valley Interfaith Fellowship is sponsoring a series of meetings to help community members learn about the Opioid Crisis in our area. This may be a sensitive topic to some people, but opioid addiction does not discriminate with gender, race, age, or economic status. No one is immune to addiction of opioid drugs prescribed for pain after an accident or having surgery. We all want to be pain free. What happens when the prescription runs out?

These community meetings include speakers from Pocatello Police Department, ISU's Division of Health and Southeast Idaho Public Health. There are two meetings left for anyone interested to attend. The first will be at Marshall Public Library at 12:00 noon on July 19th. The second will be at the First United Methodist Church at 6:00 PM on July 30th. I attended an earlier meeting and gained valuable information.

I urge everyone with a smart phone to scan this QR Code to access all the prevention resources provided by the Southeast Idaho Health Department. These include: County Resources available in all counties in our Health District; Educational Materials like drug disposal options, non-opioid treatments for chronic pain, and risk of Fentanyl overdose deaths in schoolaged youth; images of common street drugs that may be laced with a lethal dose of Fentanyl. The standard one is a blue pill stamped with an "M" and a number on the back. I highly recommend that everyone watch the short video, "Real Deal on Fentanyl/Youth Fentanyl Awareness".

The frightening truth is that Fentanyl now comes in powder form and can lace any product. Chief of Police Roger Schei told us about a high school student who overdosed while vaping. He was saved with the drug Naloxone. We know it as Narcan. 68% of drug overdose deaths in Idaho are from illegal drugs laced with Fentanyl.

For the safety of Our Gathering Place and My Brothers' Table we now have Narcan in the first aid supplies in the parish hall and will be posting instructions on how to use it. It will not harm the person in crisis but will only work if the overdose is from Fentanyl. We have to keep everyone safe.

Episcopal Church Women

Episcopal Church Women (ECW) held no meeting in June because we were busy the week of June 5th preparing for the rummage sale on June 9th and 10th. We would like to thank everyone who helped make the sale a success, especially Wendy Rowe. She did a great job seeing to every detail. We will have \$2,068 in the clear after Idaho sales tax is paid. ECW will continue to use the money when a need arises for the church or its ministries.

We are taking a vacation from ECW in July. Our next meeting will be in August to get ready for Blessing the Back-packs before school starts. All women of the church, ages 16 and up are members of ECW and welcome to attend. Have a great summer!
