Happy summer, all! Happy fourth of July... happy trails and travels... happy lemonade and ice cream and long summer evenings.

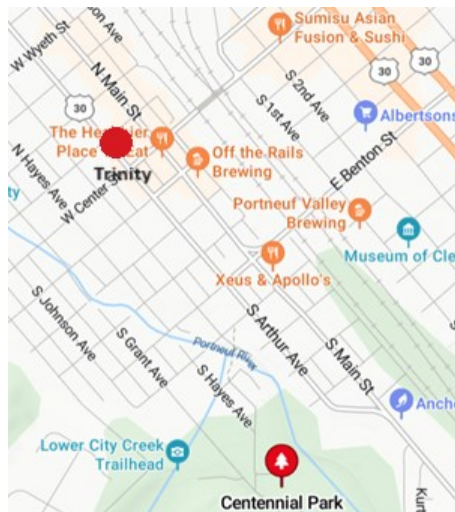

- \$51,832.40 (52%) of its 2024 pledge income.
- \$10,369 (1.30%) of its anticipated 2024 open plate income.

New Presiding Bishop Elected

The Rt. Rev. Sean Rowe, bishop of Northwest Pennsylvania and bishop provisional of Western New York, will serve as the 28th presiding bishop of The Episcopal Church. Elected on the first ballot by the House of Bishops and confirmed almost unanimously by the House of Deputies, Rowe, 49, will be the church's youngest leader in more than 200 years. His nine-year term as the church's face, voice, and chief pastor will begin on Nov. 1.



Episcopal Church Weavers (ECW)

ECW held the annual Rummage Sale on June 7th and 8th. We would like to thank everyone who gave their time, talent and treasures to make the sale a success. We made \$2,000 of which half traditionally goes to My Brothers Table and half to needs of the church.

In August we will have a project on the 17th in connection with blessing the backpacks before school begins. Our children can all afford school supplies and their own backpack, but many families cannot. Ideas for a project to help others with school supplies would be appreciated.

ECW is no longer a women's organization. Everyone in the church who wants to take part in church projects and activities will be very welcome.

50 Years of Women's Ordination

Yup: 50 years. On July 29, 1974, the first eleven women were ordained in Philadelphia as Episcopal priests. That ordination was controversial, and it wasn't exactly "legal." The new priests had previously been ordained as deacons, but women would have no formal path to the priesthood until General Convention created one in 1976. Canonical ordinations began on Jan. 1, 1977.

Women now serve across the church as deacons, priests, and bishops. In 2006, the Rt. Rev. Katharine Jefferts Schori became Presiding Bishop; more than 45 women are active bishops today.

The church is thankful for all its clergy, both male and female. This month, however, we give especial thanks for the courage and faith of the "Philadelphia Eleven" and for the bishops who ordained them.
