To the saints at First Presbyterian:

Greetings. Summer is rapidly approaching and vacations are being planned. Hurricane season is before us too. All the fun and games of living somewhat near the coast. Sure hope we miss them like last year. Hope everyone is getting prepared just in case.

As we age, things happen to our bodies. They wear out. Same thing to buildings, they wear out and wood rots, trees die, and lights need replacing. Here at church we are facing several things that need to be addressed to fix our aging facilities.

The Building and Grounds committee did a survey of needs to our buildings and came up with the need for \$20,000 to fix up things that need to be fixed. Wood around sanctuary and library area need replacing, wood around stain glass window at back of church as well, lights in fellowship hall need to be replaced with more efficient lighting, dead trees need to be removed before they fall on buildings, one air conditioner needs a drain, covering behind cross in sanctuary needs replacement covering. Think this list covers what we need but I could have left something off.

To take care of all this, Presbytery has a loan program that will lend us the money. It has an interest rate less than the going present rate at other lending companies. To secure the loan, we have to show that we are able to repay and make the monthly payments. To do this we will need 24 families committing to \$35 a month over what contributions they are currently making to the church, for two years to repay the \$840+/- monthly payment. That's all, just \$35 more.

There will be a congregational meeting May 19 to further explain this and seek the commitment so we can apply for the funds. I hope all of you will consider being part of the 24+ families to fix up our facilities.

Some needs are more important than others, or at least not as pressing, but the wood around church is very important, especially around stain glass window.

I sincerely hope you will commit to restoring what needs to be restored. This is a beautiful church that stands out among all other churches. Hope you will keep it that way.
