To the saints at First Presbyterian:

Greetings. On June 11, there will be a guest minister leading worship since I will be on vacation. It is Amy Klinkovsky. She has been here before and has done a great job filling the pulpit. Herb Myers will preach June 18 since I will be returning from vacation on that Sunday.

On June 11, Marissa will be talking to you after worship about the form you will need to fill out for Presbytery dealing with the search for a new minister. The form asks the church seeking a minister a lot of pertinent questions. I hope as many of you as possible can come that Sunday to see what you will need to do to fill out this form to secure a new minster for your future. The prospective candidates will take this form and read it as to what kind of church you are and what you want in a minister. The more of you that can share your thoughts the better it will be.

You have two choices: an Installed Minister goes through the Board of Pensions and will require 50+ thousand to fulfill the financial package you will need to have. Your saving grace is that you have a Manse. That takes away a large part of the call package under the heading of Housing Allowance. As a congregation, you will vote on the call to a new person.

Second option is to call a Stated Supply, which is the position I hold. This position is a lot less costly since this position doesn't have to go through the Board of Pensions. This person is no different from an Installed pastor in his/her duties except this position is called by the Session and is not installed by Presbytery.

I am not leaving any time soon so you will not have a vacancy to try and fill in a rush. I'm good as long as you need me. I will help you go through the process of filling out this form.

The financial package will ultimately determine the kind of minister you can call. If the funds aren't there to call an Installed pastor, there is enough finances to call Stated Supply. Stated Supply's can stay as long as you want them to stay. The Session just has to renew the contract each year as well as the pastor signs on for another year.

This is usually a long process but you have a lot of really great things going for you which should attract prospective candidates.

It's an orderly process and presbytery will help us to accomplish this task. You can act on the form anytime you want to.


