2025 Fall Indoor 3D League

WHEN: Tuesday nights at 6pm for 9 weeks starting Oct. 21st, 2025 thru Dec. 16th 2025.

COST: \$160 per team, (\$80 per shooter). Fees are to be paid in full during the first night of shooting before receiving a scorecard. This is a cash payout league. Payout is based on the number of teams.

TEAMS: League will consist of 2 person teams, if you don't have a partner, we'll help get you one. No ghost shooters this year. Both team members <u>must</u> shoot the same class. <u>Classes other than "Open" will require a minimum of 3 teams to have a separate shoot-off or payout.</u>

FORMAT: 10 lanes, 2 targets per lane, shooters will shoot 1 arrow per target. Weeks 1-8 will consist of (20) 3D targets scoring center 12's.

SCORING: NEW FOR 2025 – BEST ARROW - 14's ARE NOT in play when available on the target. Also, (2) 12's will equal a "13". Otherwise, standard scoring will be (13) 12-10-8-5-0. If a shooter misses the target...there is no second arrow. 14's WILL be in play for the shoot-off night.

Team scoring will be an accumulation of points earned by ranking the teams each night/week based on the number of teams. Example: If there are 10 teams, the points earned will cascade down from 10pts. 1st - 10pts, $2^{nd} - 9pts$, $3^{rd} - 8pts$, $4^{th} - 7pts$, etc...down to the last place team of the night.

NEW FOR 2025 – SHOOT-OFF: Points accumulated from all 8 weeks of shooting will be used to determine the teams making the shootoff. The number of teams to make the shoot-off will be determined by the number of teams in the league. The "shoot-off night" will be 5 target scramble style shoot-off. All teams will start with no accumulated points, all teams start with no score.

No ghosts, substitutes, pool scores, dupes or averages will be used. All scoring will be done by another team, NO exceptions!

In the event of a kick-out. The first arrow must have "no longer shootable" damage. "No longer shootable" damaged is defined as; the arrow is damaged to the point that it cannot be fixed; a broken nock and/or dented bushing is NOT "no longer shootable" damage.

SHOTGUN START: Teams will draw a starting lane each week before shooting and all will start at the 6pm start time, teams will rotate to the right after shooting and scoring is complete for that lane until all lanes are completed for league score. Ex... If you draw to start on lane 7 you will finish on lane 6. Bales will be setup in the range for warmup/practice before scoring begins. Do not shoot 3D targets for warmup.

IF YOU ARE LATE: All teams must start at 6pm with the rest of the league. If one team member is present at the start, they must start with the group and the late team member may join them on their current target and finish the night. They <u>cannot</u> go back and shoot the targets they missed. There are no warm-up lanes.

If both team members arrive late, they must join the other shooters in an open lane but are finished when the rest of the group finishes, there are no make-up targets and no warm-up lanes. BE ON TIME!

CLASSES:

<u>Open Class</u>: No bow restrictions, unless said equipment prompts safety concerns from the other shooters. Field points only.

Hunter Class: No lens in the sight, lens in the peep is allowed.

Stabilizer setup must not exceed 15" past front or rear of riser.

Standard hunting arrow shafts not exceeding 23/64 dia... Glue in points are allowed.

We will have a Woman's class if there are 3 or more teams signed up at the first league night.

If there are not at least 3 teams to make up a bowhunter or women's class all teams will compete in the Open class.

Binoculars and rangefinders are allowed in all classes/events. No laser sights or crossbows.

All Shooters and spectators will follow all range rules.

As always, we reserve the right to adjust the league format to make run smoother.
