In the morning if your air conditioner and hot water are on, you start the coffee pot, make some toast and turn on the TV, you are pulling 55 amps. Most RV's have a switch so you can only run the microwave OR water heater at one time, but some do not this feature. Most electrical products show how many watts or amps it takes to operate on the product itsor the instructions. If it shows the watts, divide the watts by 120 volts and that gives you the amps.
