#### AMENDMENT II

ARTICLE I Definitions

Section 1. For voting eligibility, please refer to BY-LAWS, PAGE 1, SECTION 3, MEMBERSHIP

## ARTICLE II Restrictions and Covenants

32. Amendment: These Covenants, Conditions & Restrictions may be altered, amended, or repealed and new Covenants, Conditions & Restrictions may be adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Members present at a general meeting. Notice of the proposed change(s) shall be published at least ten (10) days prior to the meeting. Any such amendment(s) shall not become effective until the instrument evidencing such change has been filed for record in the Office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Gwinnett County, Georgia. Every purchaser or grantee of any interest in any real property now or thereafter subjected to this Declaration, by acceptance of a deed or other conveyance therefore, thereby agrees that this Declaration may be amended as provided in this Section.

This Amendment has been approved in writing by fifty-three (53) or 91.4% of the eligible to wote homeowners in the Sweetbriar Crossing subdivision in accordance with the voting requirements set forth in the By-Laws, Section 3, Membership which defines a homeowner and those "eligible-to-vote."
