- 1. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 12:00 noon by Randy Bruer, Chairman.
- 2. Agenda: M/S/C: (Jorgensen/Carlson) to approve the agenda with the addition of "Marshall-Roseau Collaborative."
- 3. Approval of minutes of September 7, 2018: M/S/C: (Kujava/Bisek) to approve the minutes.
- 4. Financials and Bills:

- 5. **Bi-Annual Meeting Follow-Up:** All members felt it had been a successful meeting with 39 registered. State Representative Deb Kiel and former Senator LeRoy Stumpf were both present. Speakers were excellent. Joe Rand, in particular, gave attendees much food for thought and some members have asked to meet with him to discuss further talks.
- 6. <u>Marshall-Roseau Collaborative:</u> Kujava reported they are meeting on October 27<sup>th</sup> and the agreement should be completed and signed by November 1<sup>st</sup>. The two collaboratives will partner, but still be separate entities.
- 7. Grant Opportunities and Reports:
  - <u>System of Care:</u> The contract award is 30% less than was requested and, due to these reductions, Ada and Win-E-Mac will now be the only schools participating. Family partners will be recruited locally. The contracts will be fore 12 months each year with some flexible timing. The Department of Human Services will provide some training on ethics and confidentiality, as will the Northwestern Mental Health Center. The board expressed concern that MacRae not be overloaded with work for this project, in addition to what she already does for the Collaborative. She will track her proportions of time spent on grantwriting/website work, research, and special projects.
