
Lower Paxton Township Authority Construction Traffic Update for Weeks of March 2 and March 9

 - O Work will take place during the hours of 6:30 am and 5:00 pm Monday through Thursday. All roads will be reopened at the end of each working day. Contractor will be required to maintain access to properties and allow school buses and refuse trucks through the work zone. Some coordination could be required at times.
